#### Dear Parents and Children,

In the Catholic Church the month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This great feast in the Church is always celebrated on the octave day of Corpus Christi, the feast which celebrates the Body and Blood of Christ. Corpus Christi falls on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday which means the feast of the Sacred Heart falls nineteen days after Pentecost Sunday.

Devotion to Jesus' Sacred Heart is perhaps the most popular in the Church today and it had its beginnings in 17th century France. In 1672, Christ appeared to a French Visitation nun, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. Over a series of visits, Our Lord revealed to St. Margaret Mary the importance of devotion to His Sacred Heart. He asked that His heart, wounded on the cross and continually wounded by ingratitude of men for his sacrifice for them, be venerated and adored as an embodiment of His Divine mercy and love.

Jesus especially asked that all people go to Confession and receive Holy Communion often. He also requested that the Church observe a feast day specifically for the purpose of reparation. In 1856, the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart was officially added to the liturgical calendar.



#### Mass to Celebrate 200 years of Catholic Education in Australia.

On the 24th May Zaiven, Loa, Mrs Potts and Mr Patchell went to mass at St. Patrick's Cathedral Parramatta to celebrate the 200 hundred year anniversary of Catholic Education in Australia. 
