Late Arrival / Early Departures from School

The Catholic Education Office Diocese of Parramatta is focusing heavily on student attendance and particularly, late arrivals and early departures from school.

Not only do partial absences amount to missed learning time for your children, they interrupt learning for other children. While we understand that there are some times when your cannot avoid being late, we ask that you make a concerted effort to please get your children to school on time.

A bigger interruption to teaching time is however the amount of people who sign their children out early—often for no particular

reason. These departures are a major interruption in classes. Some classes can be called up to 6 times in a one hour period to send children to the office. Please avoid signing your children out early.

Office staff will be asking for a specific reason why you are taking your child home early and this will be recorded as an attendance note in your child's school record.



SCHOOL ZONE OFFENCES WHAT ARE YOU RISKING? *



Children are small, harder to see, behave unpredictably and are extremely vulnerable. They need **YOU** to take extra care when driving and parking around school zones.



NO PARKING No waiting. You have 2 minutes to drop-off or pick-up.

\$ 191 +2 DEMERIT You must stay within 3 metres of your vehicle

NO STOPPING You must **not stop** on a length of road with a **no stopping** sign. The first 10 metres from an intersection is a no stopping

U TURNS

U turns are **illegal** on or near a **pedestrian crossing** and across a double white line.

of your vehicle can stop on a pedestrian crossing.

2. Do not let your child in or out of a vehicle at a pedestrian

crossing as this is a No Stopping
